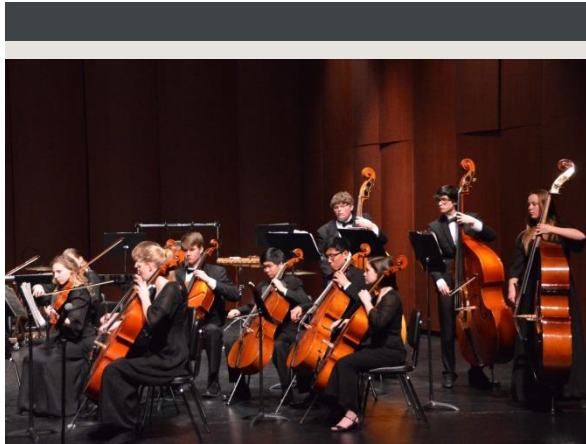
Director's Notes Vocal

Sheri Erickson has been teaching music for 32 years. She has taught at the elementary and secondary levels and is currently the Director of Choral Music at Bothell High School.

Under her leadership the choirs have continued to uphold the Bothell High School tradition of excellence as they have received superior ratings at festivals and contests in the Pacific Northwest.

In addition to her work at Bothell, Mrs. Erickson is a vocal coach for the Seattle Children's Chorus. She is a frequent adjudicator of choir and solo and ensemble festivals in the greater Seattle area. Mrs. Erickson has sung with the Seattle Symphony Chorale and Northwest Chamber Chorus and has served as the associate director of the Choir of the Sound in the Seattle area.

Her professional affiliations include the Washington Music Educators Association, the American Choral Directors Association and the National Association of Teachers of Singing. Mrs. Erickson holds a Bachelor of Arts in Music and a Master of Arts in Music Education from the University of Washington.



Director's Notes Instrumental

Philip Dean is currently serving his sixth year as Instrumental Music Director at Bothell High School. Mr. Dean directs the Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, Chamber Orchestra, String Orchestra, Full Symphony Orchestra and Jazz Band at BHS.

The Wind Ensemble performed in March at the 2014 Music For All National Concert Band Festival in Indianapolis and at the 2013 National Association for Music Education Northwest Division Conference in February 2013. The Chamber Orchestra performed at the 2011 MENC Northwest Division Conference in February 2011 and the Midwest Clinic in December 2011.

The Jazz Band performed at the 2014 Hot Java Cool Jazz concert sponsored by Starbucks, consistently places in the top three bands at regional Jazz Festivals and is featured on the 10th annual KPLU School of Jazz CD.

In addition to teaching full time at BHS, Mr. Dean is an active musician in the Seattle area. He is currently the Principal Trombone player for the Seattle Wind Symphony. Mr. Dean holds a Bachelor's Degree from Central Washington University in Trombone Performance as well as a Master of Music degree in Music Conducting.
